Grad Night Party Thursday, June 2, 9:00 p.m. Epicenter

What to Know Ahead of Time:

No tickets are issued. Grads' names will be on a master list at the door. Students must sign up and pay in advance (\$75). Scholarships are available; just ask your counselor. A contract signed by the student and parent (if student is under 18) is required. On-line Epicenter Waiver needs to be completed prior to entry – preferably prior to June 2 (signed by the student and parent (if student is under 18).

This is an alcohol-free and drug-free event. Grads found in possession and/or under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed entry to the party and will be supervised until picked up by a parent or guardian.

Grads will have time between the graduation ceremony and the Grad Night Party to eat dinner and celebrate with family. Food and drinks will also be served at the party.

- Dress comfortably for activities.
- A phone charging station is on location.
- Sleeping bags/blankets will not be allowed.
- No outside food or drinks, except with written medical authorization.
- Gum chewing, smoking, and use of tobacco products, including vaping, are not permitted on the premises.

Upon Arrival:

- Doors open at 9:00 p.m. Grads must arrive before 10:00 p.m.
- If a grad has signed up but has not arrived by 10:00 p.m., a parent/guardian will be called.
- Upon arrival, grads will be checked in and Epicenter Waivers confirmed.
- Upon admission, every grad will automatically be entered into a drawing to win all night raffle prizes. Must be present to win. Large raffle drawing will be held at 4:30 a.m. Must be present to win.
- Personal items, including bags, backpacks and prizes, will be secured in a locker room. Grads will have access to their belongings throughout the night. Please label personal items.
- Grads are encouraged to check out all of the activities, food, and entertainment.
- Phones must be used responsibly.
- Grads may not leave the event and return.

If grad wishes to leave early, the following policy applies:

- Regardless of grad's age, a parent/guardian will be notified.
- Under18–Parent/guardian picks up and signs out grad.
- 18 or older–Valid driver's license or identification is verified to confirm age.
- Any grad over 18 driving themselves home will be escorted to vehicle by PG staff. Early dismissal procedure will be followed.

After the Party:

- Party ends approximately 5:00 a.m.
- Parents: your grads will have a great time, and they will be exhausted and sleep-deprived. Please plan on picking them up, even when they insist they are fine!
